We operate exclusively as a private pay, concierge-style practice, offering highly individualized, wraparound services, including in-depth case management, to meet each client's unique needs. Our clinicians and interns maintain **smaller caseloads** to provide more comprehensive and holistic care.

Clearview serves clients of all ages at our offices in Sudbury, MA, and Worcester, MA. Our newly designed Sudbury location features private offices, high-end furnishings, original artwork, and a dedicated children's and teen therapy room filled with therapeutic toys and games. The space accommodates individual sessions, group therapy, family therapy, play therapy, expressive arts therapies, and professional trainings. We also offer in-home and community-based therapy when clinically indicated, and about 50% of our clients utilize telehealth or a hybrid model.

Clearview is **clinician-owned**, prioritizing **staff well-being** and immersive training. Supervision is led by an **international expert in OCD and related disorders** with extensive experience mentoring interns and early-career clinicians. We emphasize a **collaborative**, **team-based approach** where clinicians support one another, frequently co-facilitating cases and groups in a **collegial**, **supportive environment**.

Graduate Internship Experience

Interns begin with orientation, training, and session shadowing in June to prepare for a small caseload by August or September. Our **self-paced summer training program** allows students to balance learning with other commitments. Interns gain access to **Clearview's proprietary online training hub**, featuring real client intakes, therapy session recordings, and curated resources (books, podcasts, etc.). Shadowing opportunities (virtual and in-person) with a licensed supervisor are included, and practicum hours are typically completed before fall semester begins. By the end of the internship, students gain proficiency in **evidence-based interventions**, including:
